• ALL THE BLESSINGS AND FAVOUR THAT GOD'S FORGIVING GRACE BRINGS TO US.

- 1 When we embrace the forgiving grace of God to us at the cross, in Christ's death, burial and Resurrection, we experience **freedom, refreshing** and the **Holy Spirit's anointing.**

- **Freedom.... Rom.6:14 For sin shall not [any longer] exert dominion over you, since now you are not under Law [as slaves], but under grace [as subjects of God's favour and mercy].**

- **Refreshing...** 403 Str anapsuxis (an-aps-ook-sis), to cool off and revive, a revival, a recovering of strength, to destress and give strength
- Acts 3:19 So repent (change your mind and purpose); turn around and return [to God], that your sins may be erased (blotted out, wiped clean), **that times of refreshing** (of recovering from the effects of heat, of reviving with fresh air) may come from the presence of the Lord;

- **Anointing...** Acts 2:38 And Peter answered them, Repent (change your views and purpose to accept the will of God in your inner selves instead of rejecting it) and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for (showing, to) the forgiveness of and release from your sins; and **you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.**

2 When we fully embrace the Forgiving Grace of God to us shown in Christ at the Cross, we experience a rest and deliverance from living on Struggle St....the tiredness and emotional draining of living on Struggle St. leaves you and you experience R1 REST. (Soul Rest)

- Mt.11:28-30 Come to Me, all you who labour and are heavy-laden and overburdened, and I will cause you to rest. [I will ease and relieve and refresh your souls.]29 Take My yoke upon you and learn of Me, for I am gentle (meek) and humble (lowly) in heart, and you will find rest (relief and ease and refreshment and recreation and blessed quiet) for your souls.

30. For My yoke is wholesome (useful, good—not harsh, hard, sharp, or pressing, but comfortable, gracious, and pleasant), and My burden is light and easy to be borne.

3. When we embrace Forgiving Grace we experience and enjoy a well of thanksgiving and worship to God. E.g. Mary Magdalene. He/She who is forgiven much, loves much.

- Lk.7:36-5037 And behold, a woman of the town who was an especially wicked sinner, when she learned that He was reclining at table in the Pharisee's house, brought an alabaster flask of ointment (perfume).

4. God's forgiving Grace, when embraced, helps you not to be judgmental of others...it removes anger, resentment and rejection from our lives. Eph.4:32 And become useful and helpful and **kind to one another, tenderhearted (compassionate, understanding, loving- hearted), forgiving one another [readily and freely], as God in Christ forgave you.**

When we realize that Christ has forgiven us forever, of all our sin and remembers them no more...**then we are empowered to enjoy and experience the ability to forgive all others...forever!...**we now enjoy being kind and tender-hearted.

5. We now can come boldly to our Father God and to our High Priest Jesus for all grace that we need. We now can enter the Most Holy Place and enjoy!

Mt.27:50-53 50 And Jesus cried again with a loud voice and gave up His spirit.51 And at once the curtain of the sanctuary of the temple was torn in two from top to bottom; the earth shook and the rocks were split.52 The tombs were opened and many bodies of the saints who had fallen asleep in death were raised [to life];53 And coming out of the tombs after His resurrection, they went into the holy city and appeared to many people14

6.Through receiving His forgiveness through his shed blood, we can now enjoy being in the New Covenant...where all that belongs to Him, belongs to us...all grace, all favour, all prosperity in every area. Mat.26:27-28 **27 And He took a cup, and when He had given thanks, He gave it to them, saying, Drink of it, all of you;28 For this is My blood of the new covenant, which [ratifies the agreement and] is being poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins. All believers interact now as we take communion.**
